It is more than just the color and fluff - I consider A LOT of factors when selecting animal projects travel thousands of miles each year so that you can be successful in the show ring.

Questions to ask as a family:

- 1. How much money can we spend
- 2. What are our options for shows to attend
- 3. Hair vs. slick shear show or multi purpose steer



Where Do I purchase? Know that prices are up this year(feed cost, fertilizer etc.)

- Various Texas and Oklahoma Reputable show steer Breeders
- I've been around the industry for 30 plus years and know a lot of folks in the industry
- I don't like buying animals solely by online pics and videos (DANGEROUS)!!
- Private Treaty Sales
- Live Auctions
- Phone bid offs
- Online auctions (only if I have seen the animal in person)
- I invite you to go with me to help in the process, or you can tell me your budget and I contact you while at the sales to confirm. You send me with a check that I fill out straight to the breeder. (in the memo you designate your top dollar)

When do we purchase

- March/April Purchase
- Deadline to validate (June)
- How old are the steers when we purchase (born July-September)
 - If you get a spring born (April/May) they will be shown at County/ Ft.Worth livestock shows only would be too big to go through to later shows.
 - Late sept and early october's will only probably go to Houston wont meet minimum weight guidelines for the show otherwise.
- Breeds to consider
 - Categories to consider (American, British, Exotic)
 - Temperament
 - Show destination

Once you have your steer what to expect:

- Daily care/chores
- Daily time frame to expect
- Feeding, daily health checks, hair care etc...
- Weekend practice shows
- Show ready (Clipping)Mrs. Schertz (FREE) if you seek outside sources (reputable experienced clippers charge \$250-400/calf) for care advisement and clipping assistance, you will have to haul your animal to them, not done at the Ag barn if that is the route that you choose. (give past examples)
- Summer travel plans??
- Summer Dates: Cow Camp, State FFA Convention, possible summer show if not too hot
- Outside visitors to the barn barn contract rules
- Daily care routine: AM vs PM
- Parent visit to the barn minimum 1x week your involvement of just being there leads to the success of your child's project and the cleanliness of our school farm

- 2-3 Jackpot shows (Practice)
- Collin County Junior Livestock Show (Hair Show)
- Ft.Worth Livestock Show (Hair Show)
- San Antonio (Slick Show)
- Houston (Slick Show)

Outside Help

IF you solicit help outside, that will be your coach moving forward. I do not allow fitters in our barn so if you hire them, you haul them.

A lot of people will try to offer their advice, remember their experience may be limited or they may not know all of the rules associated with the show industry in Texas. I can't /won't help if you have multiple coaches, not fair to you, me, and especially the animal.

- Put on the market truck at the last show current market cattle price
 - (could be: \$1.30/pound or \$2.00 per pound) depends on the current market
- All steers out by April will have to have room for new baby steers

- If your child is a current 9th or 10th grader-in October we can sign them up for scramble at Houston, if they catch get \$1700 towards steer purchase for 2023-2024




- Houston Livestock Show Intent letter Opens Online: August
- Deadline to submit Houston Intent form: September 15th
- Last Day to purchase & Weigh steer for beginning weight: Sept 30th
- Weight Slips Due online: October 10th
- Entry Deadline (Same as all other entries) Dec 1st We have a sooner deadline for Allen so we have time to process. We generally have our entry meeting at the end of October or first of November
















Houston Commercial Steer Details:

Scoring Systems: The official scoring system is based on 100 points, allocated as follows:

- a. Written Test 25 pts.
- b. Interview Skills 25 pts.
- c. Steer Grades 15 pts.
- d. Record Book 10 pts.
- e. Meat ID and Quiz 10 pts.
- f. Pen of Steers Closeout 9 pts.
- g. Cost/lb. Gain 2 pts.
- h. Avg. Daily Gain 2 pts.
- i. Feed Conversion 2 pts.
