Contest Rules

The Queen, Miss and Princess candidates are required to enter a project in the Youth Fair. Candidates must meet all eligibility requirements as listed in the general rules. Multiple contestants can participate from one club/chapter but, must obtain signatures from their FFA Advisor or 4H Leader. Previous Queen, Miss and Princess winners may not run again in the same age group.

Queen Contestants must be 14 (9th grade) and up to 12th grade as of September 1, 2017.

Miss Contestants Must be 11-13 years old as of September 1, 2017.

Princess Contestants must be 3rd grade or 9 years of age to 10 years old as of Sept.1, 2017.

Queen, Miss & Princess Contestants will be judged in 5 categories:

Personality Interview, Presentation, Appearance, Most Photogenic and Raffle Ticket/CCJLS T-Shirt Sales:

- Personality Interview (50pts): candidate will be speaking to two judges with no one else listening or watching.
- Presentation (50pts): You will be judged on speech and poise during this part of judging. (See below for the presentation division rules and scoring)
- Appearance (20pt): Candidate will be judged on the amount of volunteer work that she has exhibited over the course of the week, and the way that they carry themselves while on the property; this includes: during shows when ribbons are being handed out, interaction with guests and other contestants, sportsmanship while exhibiting a project, and over all conduct while representing your chapter or club on the fairgrounds.
- Advertisement/Sales (50pts) – Amount sold will be tallied per age division.
 - Flyers & posters around Collin County, raffle tickets.
- Photogenic (30pts): You will submit a 4 x 6 headshot of yourself for judging by the published deadline. This photo may be taken at home or by a professional. The judgment will not be on the quality of the photo or how it is taken, simply on the photogenic ability of the contestant in the photo. Keep in mind that these photos will be submitted to the Star Newspaper for publishing with a write up to publically announce the contestants. (These photos need to be from the waist up)
- All five categories will be totaled to obtain a winner; consistency is key. It is possible to win 2 categories but score low in another therefore allowing another contestant to win the crown. The meeting held on November 5th will be the opportunity to ask any questions you may have regarding this contest prior to the youth fair. Also at this meeting, all candidates will receive their packet of information regarding the week of county show events and duties assigned.

Queen Miss and Princess Candidates will be introduced before each show that they are handing out ribbons during the youth fair. The entire group will be announced at the beginning of the steer show on Friday of the youth fair. All candidates will need to check in at the Myers Event Center Landing Building at 3:00pm.

All judging will be finished before this date. The Queen, Miss & Princess candidates will be announced at this time.

*All candidates will be recognized by name and the club they are representing, at that time the winners will be announced and awards given to each age division in each category, overall 1st runner up and 2nd runner up in each age division and the overall age category winners.

Presentation / Appearance Division Layout:

1. **Presentation** (Video Presentation) Deadline for video submission is Monday Jan. 2nd @ 6pm at Myers park on a flash drive.
 - A. **Queen & Miss Speech** – Advocating for Agriculture and the Collin County Livestock Show in the recorded presentations as indicated above (Max 3 minutes) (Queen and Miss Contestants only)-35 points
The **3** speeches will be given at various Collin County meetings (ex. Lions Club, Alumni Meetings, Rotary Club, etc..)
 - B. **Princess Speech** – Introduce self and at least 4 things about themselves and why agriculture is important to them (Princess Contestants only)-35 points
2. **Appearance** / Grooming & Dress – judged through the week during ribbon facilitation
3. **Communication** Rubric to be used for the video presentation and the personal interview
 - A. Poise & Posture – 10 points
 - B. Voice & Clarity – 5 points
 - C. Correct use of grammar – 5 points
 - D. Eye contact with audience – 5 points
 - E. Appropriate use of gestures and body language – 5 points
 - F. Uniqueness of presentation – 5 points
 - G. Audience appeal – 5 points
 - H. Educational value – 5 points
 - I. Questions – 10 points
 - I. Accuracy of answers – (5 points)
 - II. Poise and self confidence – (5 points)

Your Duties as CCJLS Royalty:

You will represent CCJLS throughout the year at designated promotional events, deliver Gala Thank you notes wearing your CCJLS regalia representing CCJLS as assigned by the committee. All winners (Queen, Miss and Princess) will be required to appear at the current years ribbon auction

***If you are a graduating senior you will be required to return to the CCJLS the following year at the crowning ceremony to hand off your crown to the new CCJLS Queen.*

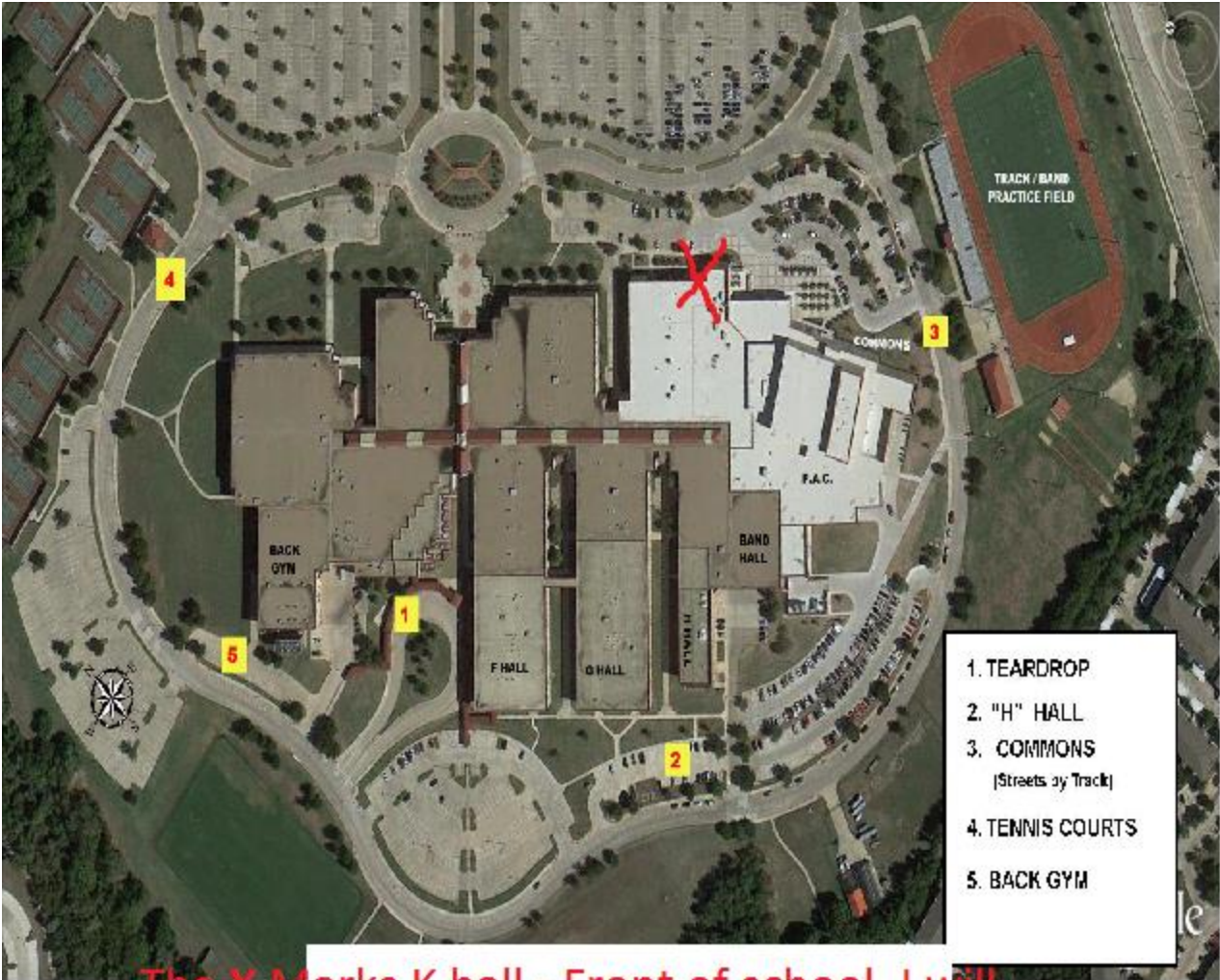
